KEY DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Work cooperatively with SSN and New Gold representatives to implement key provisions of the October 2021 Cooperation Agreement between New Gold and SSN by undertaking a consistent regime of environmental monitoring to ensure compliance with key permit conditions and other environmental conditions at the New Afton Mine property located near Kamloops, BC
- Maintain a database of environmental monitoring results and associated information
- Become aware of and work cooperatively with the cultural heritage archaeological protection activities in the New Afton Mine area
- Review and become familiar with the portion of the Cooperation Agreement between SSN and New Gold Inc relevant to the SSN environmental monitoring regime at New Afton Mine
- Provide regular and detailed reports on environmental monitoring and testing results
- Participate in meetings and group activities as required

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Diploma in Resource/Environmental Management, or similar academic background or combination of academic and lived experience
- Experience working in environmental protection; experience working in a major mine complex is an asset
- Ability to work effectively and efficiently with a diverse team, with minimal supervision
- Ability to handle confidential & culturally sensitive information in a trusted and responsible manner (willing to sign oath of confidentiality)
- Effective written and interpersonal communication skills
- Strong teamwork, problem solving and service orientation skills
- Must be willing to work flexible hours on occasion based on project requirements
- Experience working with First Nations is an asset
- Valid BC Driver's licence
- Other related duties required by SSN
